

## To Principals:

We understand that recent changes to Tournament of Champions fees have raised questions and concerns, and we want to take a moment to share the reasons behind these updates.

Over the years, the costs of running tournaments have risen. What used to be free or low-cost — fields, referees, scorekeepers, uniforms — now requires significant investment. To make sure every child has the positive experience they deserve, we are updating fees so we can provide support and resources to every participant.

This year, we are adding more professional referees and scorekeepers to address ongoing concerns about fairness and consistency. All players will also receive a reversible jersey for Tournament of Champions (performance dry-fit shirt for Volley Fest). This change was made in direct response to coach feedback and will create a more uniform and fair experience for everyone and are a valuable improvement for the players.

While no one likes to see fees increase, these changes are necessary to cover the true cost of running a high-quality event. Rather than making smaller annual adjustments, we chose to implement a single increase this year to help keep fees stable in the future. We recognize that higher fees can be a sacrifice, and we do not take that lightly. As part of our commitment to giving back to our community and supporting local schools, \$10 from every player registration continues to be donated to either Irvine Public Schools Foundation or Tustin Public Schools Foundation, depending on the student's school district.
